

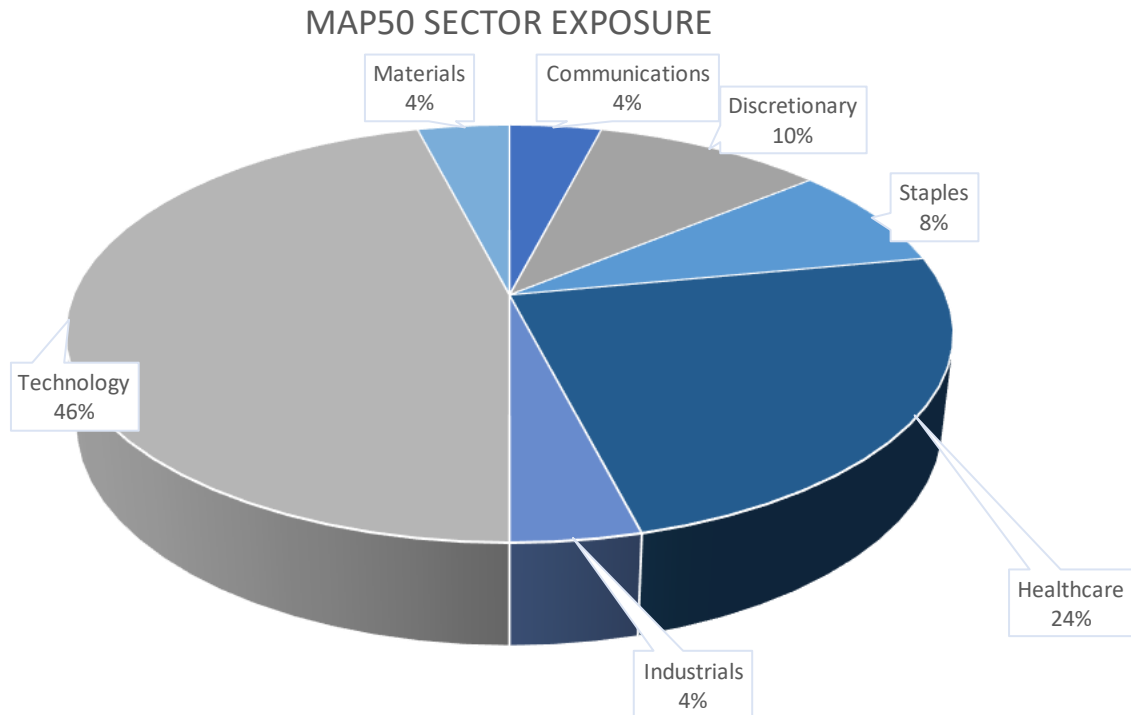
OVERVIEW

The MAP 50 this month saw 8 new entries. The last few weeks we noted more of a bullish tone in the data. Last month's report saw many names well off of their highs. This month we'd be patient through earnings season. The MAPsignals data-generated list starts by identifying stocks that can be easily traded by Big Money investors. There are usually about 1400 stocks that make up that list. We gather the best quality stocks that appeared on our MAP 20 report most frequently in the past 6 months. Outlier stocks tend to see recurring big money. We update this report each month near the 15th. New entries this month are:

SECTOR EXPOSURE

The MAP 50 shows Technology is still king with 46% of the report. Like last month, Healthcare increased its exposure to 24%. This could be related to the election...typically Healthcare names reprice since the space is always a hot topic in the debates. The remainder of the sector concentrations see a nice showing in Discretionary and Staples. As markets are firming recently, we do expect bumps until election day, but signs point to demand picking up for stocks. Earnings season is here and the best names tend to show up once the reports are out...that's where our focus will be.

HOW TO USE THE MAPSIGNALS 50

People come to us for our signals. We're in the information business. We have information you can't get anywhere else. But sometimes a lot of information can seem overwhelming. Don't worry. We're going to walk you through how to use this report. It's a collection of our most powerful signals.

Let's invest a minute to break each column down- it'll be crystal clear in no-time:

RANK: These are our highest conviction buys ranked 1 to 50; 1 being the best.

MAP20 INSTANCES 6 MONTHS: The more times a stock shows up on our weekly MAP 20 report, the better it performs over time historically speaking.

TICKER: This is the stock's exchange-traded symbol. A green ticker indicates the stock was on this week's MAP Top 20 report.

PRICE: This is the latest available closing price for the stock. We use data as of the close each day.

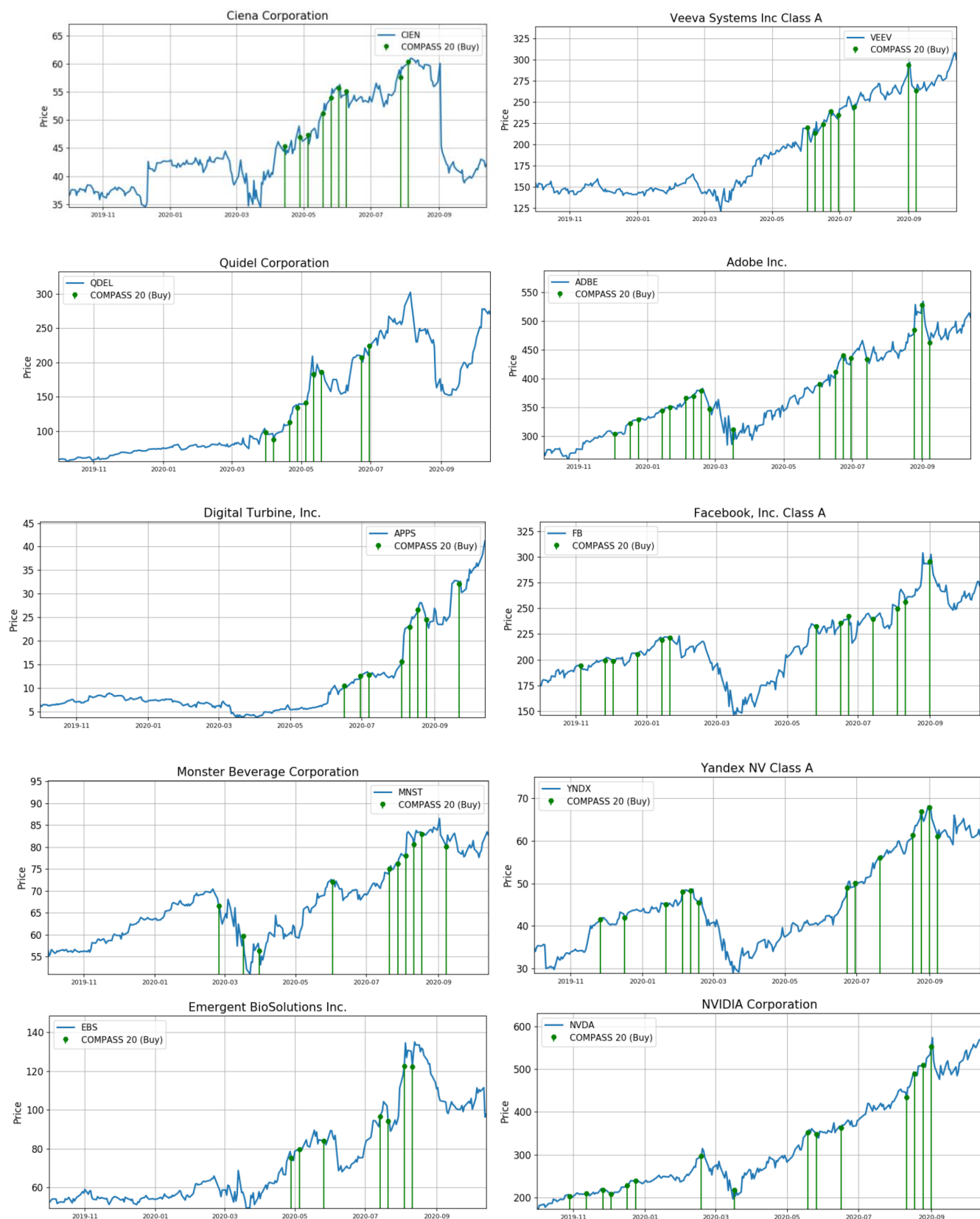
MOVED FROM MONTH PRIOR: This just tells us if the stock moved up or down in rank on the 50 list from last month.	MONTH PRIOR RANK: This just tells us where it was on the list last month. Here we see in April GOOGL moved up 4 places from 5 th in March to #1. It's like the Billboards.

MAPSIGNALS GRADES

This section off to the right of the table can seem confusing but these are powerful bits of information. It's part of what makes MAPsignals so strong at what we do. Let's go over each so you have a clear understanding of what they are and how they can help you. Just like in school, you can get an overall "GPA" which breaks down into reading/writing and math for example. MAPSCORE is the GPA. Technicals are like math and science. Fundamentals are like physical fitness and reading/writing comprehension. Stocks need to be well rounded too!

MAPSCORE: The aggregate score of how strong a stock is. Combining everything we look at – think of it as the overall grade. It's a quick way to see a stock's strength.	TECHNICAL: We call it "Mechanics." This is <i>how a stock is trading</i> . Baked in here are things like buy/sell pressure, highs, lows, and volatility. It's our view of stock technicals	FUNDAMENTAL: We call it "Health", or: <i>how healthy a stock is</i> . This has stuff like sales and earnings growth, profits, and debt. It's our view of balance sheet and future prospects.	VALUE METER: This is new. <i>Is it a good time to buy this stock?</i> A full black circle means value. A white circle means it might be better to wait for a pullback. Buying a stock with strong technicals and weak fundamentals may take longer to show performance. Here we try to help you decide on timing.
